Directions:

Todd lives at 119 Brigham Hill Rd. Essex.

From 5 Corners in Essex Jct (see Note for from Richmond), take Rt 15 toward the outlet stores/Hannaford's.

After you pass 289 & the traffic light for the outlet stores Rt. 15 will start to make a sharp turn to the Right On this corner take a Left onto Old Stage Rd.

Take Old Stage Rd. for a little over a mile.

4th road on the Left will be Brigham Hill Rd. (there is red barn across street and brick house on corner)

Make Left onto Brigham Hill Rd.

(Note - if you're coming from the Richmond area, from RT 117 take Sand Hill Rd to the end, go west (left) on RT 15, then from the intersection of Routes 15 and 128 in Essex Center, go north on Towers Road. Take a right on Old Stage Rd and your next left onto Brigham Hill Rd. (there is red barn across street and brick house on corner)).

Take Brigham Hill Rd. for a little over a mile - will turn into dirt road We're the 4th house on right after road turns to dirt, but maybe hard to distinguish since road will be covered w/ snow.

It's a brown split-level w/ 2 outbuildings. Mailbox is #119 (But I think the 9 has worn off.)
